1. Will I get my USB back?

4. How long should my video be?

Your video should be no more than two minutes in length.

5. How do I submit my video?

Yes! If they are under 18, please have them sign a general consent form (included in registration package) and send it in with your entry.

8. Should I depict people being injured in my video?

You certainly can, but it **MUST** be filmed in a safe way without causing actual injuries.

9. When will the winners be chosen?
